Our Schools	Senri and Osaka International Schools of Kwansei Gakuin are sister schools in Mino, Osaka that share a campus, purpose, and mission. The Position	We are seeking a full-time middle/high school native-level teacher of English and ESL to join our international team from April 2026. SIS has a well-established English programme catering to the needs of beginner-level students through to native English speaking returnees. The position is a full time contract and consists of 15-18 teaching hours per week. Established courses will be taught but there are also opportunities to develop challenging and engaging lessons to suit individual teaching interests. The successful applicant will be responsible for teaching, assessing and report writing and for performing all duties pertaining to full-time teachers including homeroom, parent-teacher conferences, extra-curricular activities, entrance exams, etc.

Qualifications Selection	 We are looking for a native-level English teacher with a teaching license or certificate from their home country or an advanced degree in ESL or Education. Experience in teaching the International Baccalaureate English B course and Model United Nations would be an advantage. Experience or genuine interest in curriculum development.
Criteria	 A high level of pedagogical knowledge in English Education. Experience or genuine interest in teaching English to students with diverse language backgrounds in both middle and high school. A commitment to building a positive rapport with students and to creating a student-centered environment. The ability to enrich student learning through technology. The ability to innovatively engage students in both communicative and academic English courses. The ability to work as a team, build trust and develop a shared vision. A high level of time management skills. A willingness to devote the time necessary to meet the demands of the role.
Salary and Benefits	We offer a highly competitive salary in addition to a benefits package which includes annual home leave and an overseas living allowance. You will be enrolled in the private schools mutual aid scheme for health care and national pension payments.
